ChemTec One Product Evaluation

The West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH), Materials Control, Soils and Testing (MCS&T) Division has reviewed the information packet for the product ChemTec One, submitted by ChemTec International, Incorporated. Based on the information submitted, it has been decided that ChemTec One can be used as a soluble reactive silicate concrete treatment on WVDOH projects on a project-by-project basis. A project-by-project basis is where the prime contractor will request that ChemTec One be used in lieu of an approved concrete sealer. Once approval is given, the project will be monitored to determine how ChemTec One is performing. Finally, ChemTec International, Incorporated, will notify the MCS&T Division if the ChemTec One formulation or manufacturing process changes, thus making this approval letter invalid.
